ARTICULATION AGREEMENT CONNECTICUT COMMUNITY COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM

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SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY NURSING DEPARMENT

May 3, 2010

The Connecticut Community Colleges and Southern Connecticut State University (SCSU) hereby establish the enclosed articulation agreement been the Connecticut Community College Nursing Program (CT-CCNP) and SCSU's Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Program Directors from each institution met on June 26, 2009 to compare each program's curriculum and identify possible transferability of credits from the CT-CCNP to SCSU.

This agreement guarantees admission to SCSU's nursing program upon successful completion of the associate degree from the Connecticut Community College Nursing Program and licensure as a Registered Nurse. The agreement will take effect for students graduating from the CT-CCNP beginning in spring 2010.

At SCSU, RN to BSN students must have successfully completed the following pre-requisite courses to be considered for the nursing program: ENG 112 (Composition II), MAT 108 (Math for Natural Sciences), BIO 110 (Human Biology I), BIO 111 (Human Biology II), BIO 120 (Basic Microbiology), CHE 120 (General Chemistry I), PSY 100 (Introduction to Psychology), PSY 219 (Lifespan Psychology), and MAT 107 (Elementary Statistics).

Students transferring from the CT-CCNP would have all of these program pre-requisites, with the exception of ENG 112, MAT 107 and MAT 108. Students would complete these courses either at the community college or during their first semester attending SCSU. These courses would need to be successfully completed prior to enrolling in any of the nursing course sequence.

Students who complete the CT-CCNP at one of the community colleges will transfer in a total of 30 major requirement credits to SCSU's Nursing Program, per the recommendation of the Connecticut Articulation Model for Nurse Educational Mobility.

A total of 75 credits will be transferrable between the two programs. This agreement will promote the transferability of CT-CCNP graduates interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing.
