Applicants must demonstrate they have met or exceeded the following prerequisites by providing a high school transcript and/or official college transcripts for credits earned outside NVCC. Documents must be submitted by the January 16, 2017 deadline:

- MATH:** Minimum of having completed, within the last 5 years* high school algebra II with a grade of "C" or better **AND** a placement or SAT/ACT score above intermediate algebra; **or** MAT*H136 or MAT*H137 or college level equivalent with a grade of "C" or better.
- BIOLOGY:** Minimum of having completed high school or college level Biology with a lab within the last 5 years* with a grade of "C" or better.
- SCIENCE:** Completion of an additional high school or college level science course within the last 5 years* with a grade of "C" or better.
- ENGLISH:** Minimum of having completed developmental English course (ENG*H063 or equivalent); **or** Accuplacer placement test results recommending ENG*H101; **or** SAT/ACT results for either Reading or Writing at or above the score for placement into ENG*H101 English Composition.
- GPA:** Minimum 2.5 GPA based only on the college courses with grades that meet the Radiologic Technology Admission and Radiologic Technology program curriculum requirements.

**"within the last five (5) years" is defined as having completed the course/requirement in the Fall of 2012 or later.*

The radiologic technologist is the assistant to the radiologist, a physician who specializes in the use of X-rays and radioactive isotopes. Since X-rays are important tools for the diagnosis of disease, radiologic technologists are valued members of the health team. The Radiologic Technology Program prepares individuals for employment as radiologic technologists in hospitals, medical offices, clinics, and public health institutions.

The applicant must verify how all prerequisites to the program have been completed. Official transcripts must be submitted for all previous college work, even if the courses are not required for this program.

New or transfer students must submit an NVCC application and required documents to Admissions along with this program application. Applicants must provide the following as part of the College application process. Current NVCC students need only submit this program application:

- \$20 application fee (unless student has previously attended and paid the fee at another CT community college).
- Proof of completion of high school or GED unless applicant has earned a college degree, in which case the official college transcript with date of graduation can be substituted.
- Proof of immunity to Measles, Mumps, Rubella, and Varicella.
- Official transcripts of **all** previous college work, **regardless of relevance to the Radiologic Technology Program.**

All qualified applicants will be invited to attend a mandatory program information session. In late February/early March, applicants will be contacted via their college assigned email address to schedule attendance at a session. The deadline to register for, and attendance at an information session is strictly enforced.

All communications regarding your Radiologic Technology application status will be sent to your college assigned email address issued to you at the time of your acceptance to NVCC. Please be sure you are able to access this account and check it regularly. Instructions for accessing this account are included in your College acceptance email message sent to the personal email address provided on your NVCC College application.
