PLEASE READ ENTIRE APPLICATION CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

Admission to the Respiratory Care Program at NVCC is selective. You may qualify for this program by successfully completing the necessary prerequisites and other program admission requirements. The requirements listed are minimal admissions criteria. Course equivalencies are evaluated on case by case basis. Applicants who are not admitted to the Respiratory Care Program for 2019 and who wish to seek admission in subsequent years must reapply.

<u>New or transfer students</u> must submit an NVCC application and required documents to Admissions along with this program application. Applicants must provide the following as part of the College application process. Current NVCC students need only submit this program application:

- \$20 application fee (unless student has previously attended and paid the fee at NVCC or another CT community college).
- Proof of completion of high school or GED unless applicant has earned a college degree, in which case the official college transcript with date of graduation can be substituted.
- Proof of immunity through vaccinations or titer test to Measles, Mumps, Rubella, and Varicella.
- Official transcripts of <u>all</u> previous college work, <u>regardless of relevance to Respiratory Care Program.</u> This includes courses taken in high school where college credits were also earned.

The applicant must verify how all prerequisites to the program have been completed. Official transcripts must be submitted by the program application deadline for all previous college work, even if the courses are not required for this program. If transcript has coursework "in progress", the applicant must provide a final transcript with grade upon completion of the course and no later than the application deadline. Exceptions are made for courses taken in the winter session.

All qualified applicants will be required to attend a mandatory program information session. The deadline given to register for, and attendance at an information session is strictly enforced.

All communications regarding your Respiratory Care application status will be sent to your <u>college assigned email address</u> issued to you at the time of your acceptance to NVCC. Please be sure you are able to access this account and check it regularly. Instructions for accessing this account are included in your College acceptance email message sent to the personal email address provided on your NVCC College application. Exceptions will be made ONLY for new students who have not yet received their college email account.

Mid-February	Qualified applicants will be invited to register to attend a mandatory program information session.
