IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PLACEMENT TESTING (IF REQUIRED):

The last available date for placement testing is Monday, January 29th between 3:00pm and 5:00pm at our *Waterbury Campus*. Please check in first with the Admissions Office in Kinney Hall, room K500. Testing for the late start semester is not available at our Danbury campus.

ADVISING AND REGISTRATION:

Visit the Waterbury or Danbury campus anytime during normal business hours of Monday – Friday, 8am – 5pm for advising and registration assistance.

TUITION AND FEES:

Full payment of tuition and fees is required at the point of registration for students who do not have an official financial aid award. Note that **Financial Aid is not available to Non-Degree Students**. Methods of payment include cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, Discover or the College payment plan.
