

Thank you for applying to Naugatuck Valley Community College for the Fall 2020 semester. The semester begins on Wednesday, August 26, 2020.

YOUR NEXT STEPS: In order to register and be approved for financial aid you must first be accepted to the college by submitting the documents listed below. If you have not already done so, please submit these documents as soon as possible. Be sure to include your name and student/NetID # on all documents, which can be found in the subject line of the email. Registration for new students begins Tuesday, April 21st. If you have expressed interest in our Nursing, Respiratory Care, Radiologic Technology or Physical Therapist Assistant majors, please follow the link for important application information specific to those majors.

- 1. <u>Proof of High School Completion</u>: Copy of high school diploma, GED, or a high school transcript that includes the date of graduation is required for both acceptance into a degree or certificate program and to be eligible for financial aid. *CT. High School students expected to graduate in 2020 are initially conditionally accepted without this documentation and will have until July 7, 2020 to provide this documentation.*
- 2. <u>Immunization Requirements:</u> All degree or certificate seeking students born after 12/31/56 are required, by state law, to submit immunization documentation for 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR). Those born as of 1/1/1980 also need to submit documentation for 2 doses of Varicella (Chicken Pox). Click here for the <u>immunization form</u>or provide us with a copy of your immunization records.
- 3. <u>College and AP transcripts (if applicable)</u>: **Unofficial transcripts** may be submitted to determine placement and to meet prerequisite requirements. **Official transcripts** must be submitted by the respective College or University to qualify for transfer credits.

PLACEMENT TESTING:

In order to be properly placed into appropriate classes, students need to demonstrate proficiency levels in Math and English. Due to COVID-19, we are unable to administer placement exams at this time. In the interim, methods for demonstrating proficiency include:

- High School GPA (if current)
- SAT, ACT or GED test scores (optional but strongly encouraged to ensure proper placement). These do not need to be official. A screen shot or PDF of your scores can be accepted provided it includes the student name.
- If you do not have these items available or they are not current, you can speak with an advisor about alternative options once you have received your acceptance email.

SUBMITTING DOCUMENTATION: Scan/take a picture and email to nvcc@nv.edu.

REGISTRATION:

After all required documents are submitted, you will receive an acceptance letter and details on how to set-up your student account as well as how to sign up for a registration session or register for classes. The sooner you are accepted, the sooner you can register for classes. Classes fill guickly and sections become limited!
