



## PARENTAL CONSENT FOR UNDER AGE STUDENTS FORM

As your child transitions to college, it is important to note that:

- NVCC is much more rigorous and much less guided than secondary education course work.
- The courses taken will establish an official transcript that will follow the student throughout the student's college and/or university career.
- Adult themes and diverse perspectives are essential to NVCC materials and discourse.
- Any student who registers in NVCC courses is responsible for maintaining at least a "C" (2.00 on a 4.00 scale) cumulative grade point average (GPA).
- NVCC will not act in a parental or supervisory role.
- A parent or guardian may not attend a course in which their student is registered unless the parent or guardian is registered.
- A student who registers in NVCC courses is fully responsible for complying with all policies and procedures of NVCC. This includes being aware of and adhering to the NVCC Code of Conduct.
- Instructors cannot discuss students' attendance, grades or progress with parents over the phone and/or in person without observed written consent of the student.
- Instructors cannot inform parents when classes are cancelled at the last minute or when the class ends prior to the appointed time.
- Attendance is required, but not monitored. Most likely, no one will call if the student misses class.
- Students under the age of 18 will be required to have adult supervision for certain student activities related to student clubs and student organizations. In certain instances, such as bus trips, the College will not provide that supervision. In other instances, the student will be required to provide a signed release form.

### **Special note to parents - Right of Access:**

I have read and understand that according to state and federal regulations, my minor's college records are available to me only with their observed written consent. Parents of community college students **do not** have a right of access to their children's student records, regardless of age.
