- 2. A specific letter written by the student, documenting and describing the breakdown in relationship between student and parent(s)
- 3. Two to three letters of supporting documentation from 3rd parties (may include counselors, teachers, clergy, medical personnel, courts, prison administrators, etc.) with knowledge of your current circumstance
 - a. A signed statement from relatives and friends may serve to substitute one of the 3rd party documentation
