I. Student set

- 1. The set of General Students who have registered for one or more courses of the given Level and Term.
- 2. Seats with a Registration Status (STVRSTS) which count in the Enrollment (like 'RE', 'AU', 'RW"), and/or are grade-able are considered to be "registered."
- 3. Each student appears only once in the extract, no matter how many courses they have.
- 4. Tech-Prep may be excluded (depending on how a Parameter was answered).

When an X account user executes the report, then provide the ability for the Term parameter to permit a wildcard pattern for the last two characters ONLY, in order to produce a dataset that includes all allowable students from all twelve colleges. When run with an X account the parameter term code must contain at least four characters; if not, the report will abort with an error message.

Definitions

- 1. Semester summary hours:
 - A. Credit Academic hours
 - a) Sum of the Academic hours of the seats which count in enrollment and which have a Non-CEU Level (as per STVLEVL).
 - B. CEU Academic hours
 - a) Sum of Academic hours of the seats which count in enrollment and which have a CEU Level (as per STVLEVL).
 - C. Credit Load hours
 - a) Sum of Credit hours of the seats that count in enrollment and have a Non-CEU Level.
- 2. Registration holds:
 - A. A 'Y' means that the student has a hold on SOAHOLD which blocks Registration and whose To date is less-than-or-equal-to Today and whose From date is greater-than-or-equal-to Today.
- 3. Registration-User and Date:
 - A. The Username and Add-date of the earliest record (lowest Sequence Number) for the student on SFASTCA, within the specified Term and Level.
- 4. Full-time In this calculation, tech-prep seats are not counted
 - A. If Semester Credit Load hours is greater-than-or-equal-to 12.0, then 'F' (Full-time)
 - B. If Semester Credit Load hours equals zero (0), then '0'
 - C. Otherwise, then 'P' (Part-time)
- 5. MMR Comments -
 - A. It is possible (although incorrect) to have more than one Comment pertaining to Measles or Rubella for a person. If so, the comment returned here is based on the following precedence:
 - 1: I (Inoculated), 2 G (1999+ Graduate) 3: A (Age), 4: C (MD case), 5: T (Titer), 6: M (Medical),
 - 7: R (Religion), 8: S (Scholastic), 9 L (Distance Learning Exemption) 10 D (One-dose), P (Temp. Medical)
 - B. Only the third character is meaningful, and so only the third character is extracted. For example, 'I' for Inoculated or 'A' for Age-exempt.
 - C. Measles A comment on SPACMNT beginning with 'AM or AH or AD'

- D. Rubella A comment on SPACMNT beginning with 'AR or AH' or AD
- 6. Hold Codes (fields 10**4**-10**7**) should report only hold codes that block registration using the following hierarchy System Holds

Inactive Address XH (where X is the college letter)
MMR Hold Codes X1, XG, XM (where X is the college letter)
Any additional registration hold codes


V. Other notes

- 1. Address data is from the most recent 'MA' address where Today is between the FROM and TO dates.
- 2. Previously labeled MA Telephone data is from the most recent and active record associated with a MA address and relabeled Contact Phone, applying the following logic:

Primary indicator = Y
(SPRTELE_PRIMARY_IND = Yes)
Associated with the effective (highest sequenced) MA Address Type
(SPRTELE_ATYP_CODE = MA)

In cases where there is no primary indicator associated with the most recent effective address, select an active phone associated with it selecting the one with the highest sequence number first, otherwise leave blank.

- 3. Use only active emails that are not a URL type. Then use the preferred email address in GOAEMAL or the one listed even if preference is not checked. If preference is not listed and more than one exists, use the address with the most recent activity date.
- 4. Banner's concurrent curricula allows a student to have two programs (primary and secondary), each with two majors. This diagram gives this hierarchy along with the SWRXF05 field names for each (where available). The second major for the secondary program does not appear in the SWRXF05:



5. As of version 1.37, the SWRXF05 carries ethnic and race codes for each student, allowing the student to designate their Hispanic ethnicity separately from their race, and allowing the student to designate multiple races. In most cases, the following logic applies when counting student demographics.

For residents of known ethnicity, all Hispanic or Latino students are counted in the **Hispanic category**. Students without the Hispanic designation and with multiple races are counted in the **multiple category**. Other non-Hispanic students are sorted based on their race information. Those with a single code of 60 (Choose not to respond) are reported in the "**Race and ethnicity unknown**" category. When it appears with any other code, the code of 60 (Choose not to respond) is ignored.
