

2016 NVCC Foundation Scholarships

We are grateful for the many generous donations made by NVCC alumni, community businesses and friends of the college that fund these scholarships. The NVCC Foundation Scholarship Program awards scholarships based on academic achievement, demonstrated financial need, service to the college and community, or a combination of these factors. In order to have demonstrated financial need a FAFSA must be on file with the College.

New and returning students who attend NVCC on a full-time or part-time basis are eligible to apply for scholarships, and both degree and certificate-track students will be considered. In spring, NVCC's scholarship recipients are recognized at an annual Honors Night reception, an event where family, friends and scholarship donors gather to celebrate excellence at NVCC.

The NVCC Foundation is currently accepting applications for the attached list of scholarships. All scholarships received this spring will be applied to the fall 2016 semester. Foundation scholarship funds will be deposited into the student's 2016-2017 NVCC account and will be applied to tuition, fees and books, unless otherwise noted by the guidelines, and balances will not be paid out unless stated by the donor. Funding is restricted to NVCC courses taken in the fall and spring of the application year.

A Scholarship Application, should be printed, along with all supporting documentation and MUST be submitted <u>together</u> by the February 26, 2016 deadline. A complete scholarship package consists of a **Scholarship Application**, **Application Signature Page**, **Personal Statement**, an **Academic Letter of Recommendation**, and a **Character Reference**.
