

Dear EasyDNNgallery module users,

All versions of the EasyDNNGallery 1.x, 2.x and 3.x can be upgraded to version 4.0 without any loss of data.


Activation

New EasyDNNgallery version 4.0 requires activation and after the upgrade you will need to activate the gallery. After the update the gallery will continue to work as it is now and will have no impact on the existing created galleries. The activation form will only appear if a new gallery module instance is added to the page. To activate gallery, after the upgrade, select “**Activate**” on the menu (or add a new instance of the module to a page) and enter the **Invoice ID** that you received when you purchased EasyDNNgallery on the SnowCovered. After successful activation EasyDNNGallery continues to operate as before.

About EasyDNNgallery

Basic idea while making this gallery module was to enable DNN webmasters simple and quick solution to maintain multimedia content (images, video, audio). By using this gallery you will save your precious time.

Installation

Minimum Requirements

In order to install the module, your DotNetNuke portal must meet the following requirements:

The DotNetNuke portal must be version 04.06.02 or higher.

The DotNetNuke portal must be using Microsoft SQL

Module Installation

The following outlines the steps required to authenticate your software:

1. Log into your DotNetNuke Portal with Host privileges (Super User)
2. From the Host menu, click Module Definitions
3. Scroll to the bottom, click Install New Module
4. Choose the location of the module zip file from your local directory structure.
5. Click Install New Module

Upgrading Gallery

Before you upgrade please backup your website and your database.

It is possible to upgrade the modules from version 1.x to version 4.0

If you made changes to the CSS themes, be sure to save them so you do not lose your changes. For old themes CSS to function correctly they must be updated to the new version 4.0 In all themes new classes that have been added in version 4.0 are marked, so you can easily update existing ones without much searching.

It is also necessary if you changed the language rscx files to save them before the upgrade because

you can lose your changes. After upgrading is necessary to update localized rscx files with the new fields that were added in version 4.0

Integration with news and blog modules

Gallery can be integrated with dynamically created pages where the querystring is passed (usually EntryId, Itemid, ArticleID etc.). It is enough to put EasyDNNGallery on the page and under the "Gallery Settings" select the type of view and select the option " **Integrate this gallery display with news or blog module**", enter the querystring the news module uses and connect the article number with a number of gallery. You can easily use a variety of themes and modes of integration (except Flash Tab Gallery). Settings are applied to the entire instance of the module and can not be set for each different article.

View Flash Tab Gallery in lightbox

Flash Tab gallery is possible to display integrated into a web page or open it in lightbox by clicking on the link. Selecting the Flash Tab gallery and checking the option "embed", the gallery will be shown integrated on the page. Un-checking the option "embed" will display a link that opens a gallery in lightbox. Link text ("Flash link text") can be changed. Check the option "Generate Link Code" to get the code that can be placed anywhere on the page within the text as a text link or a link to an image or button. When doing this you can check the option "Do not show main gallery" to hide the main Flash Tab gallery from the page.

Editing CSS themes

EasyDNN Gallery has several preset themes that can very easy be modified or you can use them to create new ones. Use the existing themes as examples. Themes are located in the "/DesktopModules/EasyDNNGallery/Themes/". Just copy an existing theme and call the file a name (eg. EDGStyle1.css). To be done properly first ID selector must be named as the CSS file (example: this file is called EDGStyle1.css and the first ID selector must be called #EDGStyle1). Names may be in its sole discretion only important thing is that the name of first ID selector is the same as CSS file so the theme is valid. To quickly change the name of the first ID selector use the find / replace in your editor.

Availability

All galleries in EasyDNN Gallery are available throughout the entire portal. Just put the gallery on the page and if you have already created a gallery in the same portal, in settings select the gallery and set up display. For the same gallery you can use different views.

About categories and galleries

Content in the EasyDNNGallery module is organized into **categories** and **galleries**. Into gallery we add images, video and audio files that we wish to show. Number of galleries you can create is unlimited. Galleries are organized into categories. Categories are used to easily and better organize galleries.

Description of categories and galleries

Into the galleries we can add different multimedia files (images, video, audio). Depending on your needs galleries can contain only images or only video or only audio files, but you can also have all types of multimedia files in one gallery. Some of view types can show all three multimedia file types. In case you select view type that can only show images, only images that are in selected category will be shown. Audio and video files will not be shown. Each file you add to gallery can have its own title and description. Title and description you can edit anytime.

One gallery can be shown on multiple pages with the same or different view type.

List of view type (presentation) abilities

- **Lightbox gallery** – supports all media types (images, video, audio, flash) – jQuery, Ajax, html, css
- **Lightbox gallery with Caption Slider** - supports all media types (images, video, audio, flash)
- **Lightbox portfolio gallery** – supports all media types (images, video, audio, flash)
- **Slideshow gallery** – only images – jQuery, Ajax, html, css
- **Slideshow gallery with thumbnails** – only images – jQuery, html, css
- **Slideshow gallery with thumbnails 2** – only images – jQuery, html, css
- **Slideshow gallery with thumbnails 3** – only images – jQuery, html, css
- **Advanced Slide Show** – only images – jQuery, html, css
- **Flash Tab gallery** – images and flv video – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Video gallery** – video – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Video gallery with Caption Slider** - video – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Video gallery with Carousel** – video – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Audio gallery** – audio – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Audio gallery with thumbnails or list** – audio – flash, jQuery, html, css
- **Image slider 1** – only images – jQuery, html, css
- **Image Carousel** – images, audio, video – jQuery, html, css
- **Vertical Carousel** – images, audio, video – jQuery, html, css

1. Add Easy DNN Gallery Module on the page where you want to display the contents of gallery.
2. Click on **Manage Content** and click on **Open** in front of category name to select category in which you want to create gallery.

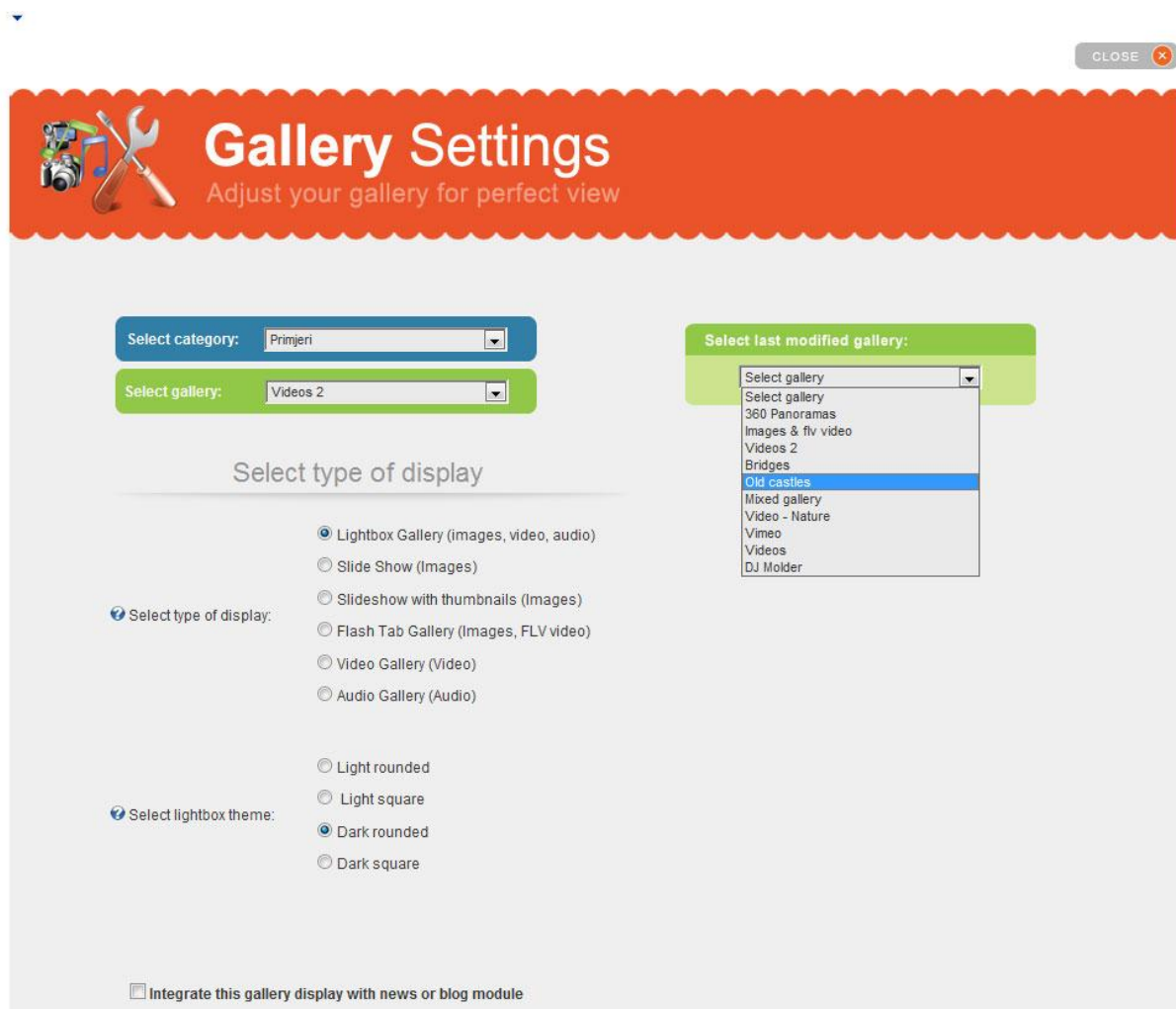



[Creating new gallery](#)

To create new gallery you need to click on **“Manage Content”** after which you will be in admin part where you can create new categories and galleries. By clicking **“Open”** in front of category we chose category in which we want to create new gallery. Beneath category list gallery admin panel will appear. We can create new gallery by entering name of the gallery into the field **“New gallery”**. We can also enter description into the field **“Description”** (not obligatory).

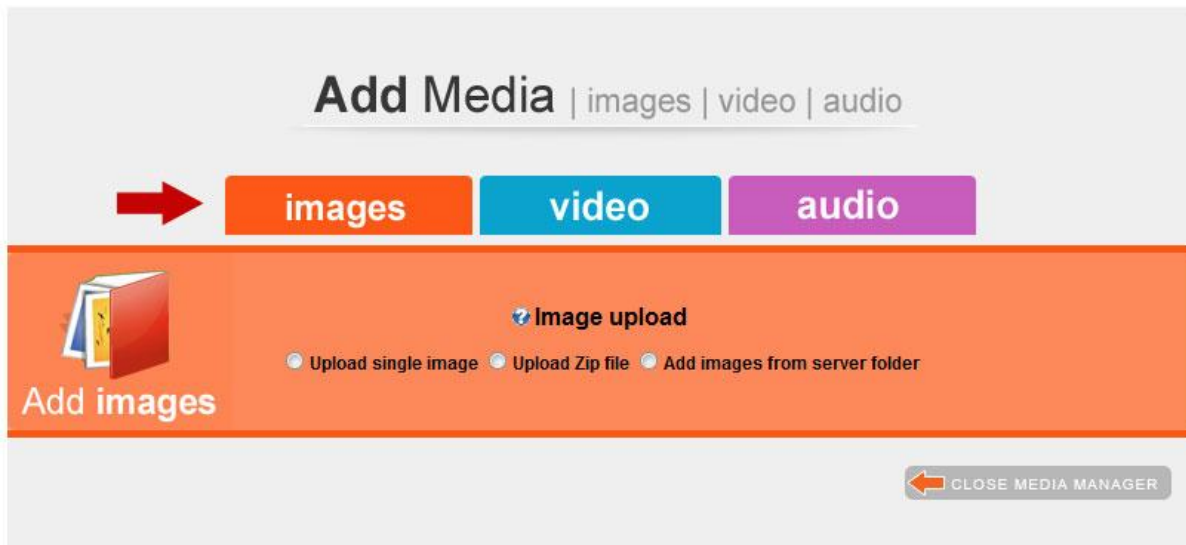
Into every gallery we can add images, video and audio files. Gallery can contain all types of files at the same time, but if we chose view type which does not support some file types these files will not be shown.

[How to add files to gallery?](#)

From the list of all galleries in category we chose gallery in which we want to add files by clicking **“Open”** in front of the name of gallery. After we have chosen gallery in which we want to add files we can see the contents of that gallery (if there is any). Beneath the contents of gallery is an upload panel. We need to select the type of files we want to add into gallery and that can be: images, video or audio.

[Adding images into gallery](#)

We add images by selecting tab images in the upload panel.



Possible methods of adding images (.jpg, .gif, .png):

Upload single image

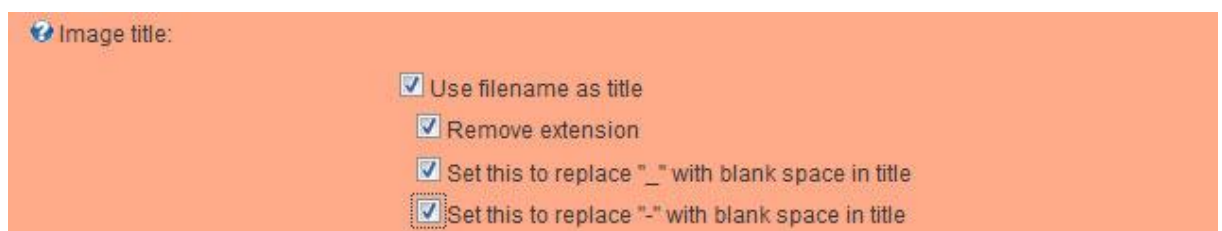
It can be used when we want to add a single image from our computer. When using this method it is possible to enter title and description. If we check option „**Use filename as title**“, image title will be created from the filename of uploaded file.

*Additional options while using option „**Use filename as title**“*

Remove extension – removes the file extension from title. e.g. „House.jpg“ becomes “House”.

Set this to replace “_” with blank space in title – replaces “_” with empty space in title. e.g. “My house” becomes “My house”.

Set this to replace “-” with blank space in title – replaces “-” with empty space in title. e.g. “My-house” becomes “My house”.



Upload Zip File

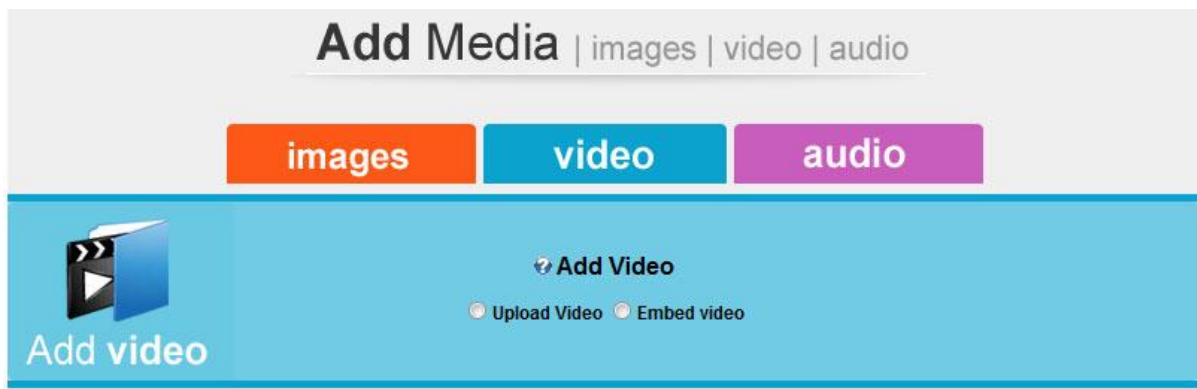
If we have more images that we want to upload from our computer, we can add them into one zip archive file. After you upload zip file into the server files from archive will be automatically added into selected gallery. You can add Zip archive from your computer (**Upload Zip file**) or you can choose from some folder on the server (**Add zip from server folder**).

Add images from server folder

Using this method we can add all image files from selected folder on the server.

[Adding video file into gallery](#)

You can add video file to the gallery from your own computer or from video sharing sites like YouTube. If you want to add your own video – you select **Upload Video**, and if you want to add into gallery video from any of supported video sites we select Embed **video**.




To add your own video (.fla, .mp4(h264), .mov) you can use the following options:

Upload video – adding video file from your computer

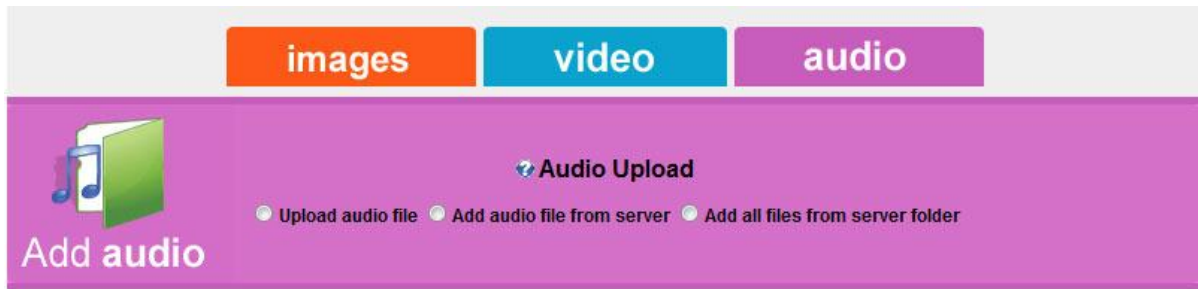
To add video from video sharing sites we use method **Embed video**.

After that you need to select one of supported sites: **YouTube, Vimeo, Dailymotion, Metacafe**. Into the field **Embed code** you copy the embed code from video sharing site. Into the field **Video url** you need to copy **http address (URL)** of the video you wish to add to gallery. You can also enter **title** and **description**. It is possible to automatically create video thumbnail, upload your own thumbnail or use the standard thumbnail.

Adding audio files into gallery


To upload audio files (.mp3) into gallery you can use following methods:



Upload audio file – adding single audio file from your computer

Add audio from file server – adding single audio file from folder on the server

Add all files from server folder – adding all audio files in one folder on the server



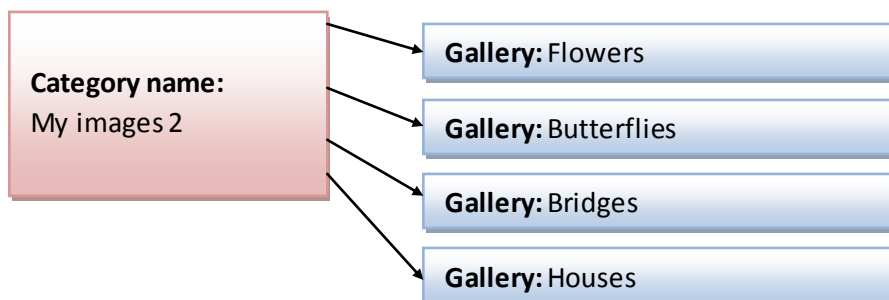
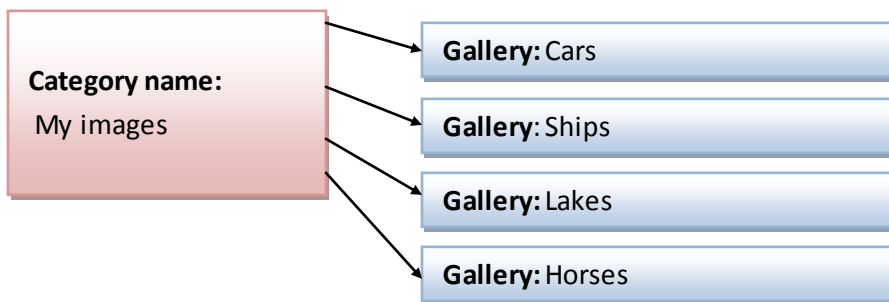

Nested galleries

EasyDNNgallery has the ability to display the category and galleries are in it as a nested galleries. Nested galleries may be used only with the Lightbox gallery view type. To make this easier to understand, it is necessary to know how the categories and galleries are organized in EasyDNNgallery.

Category may contain more galleries. Gallery may contain pictures, video, audio and flash.

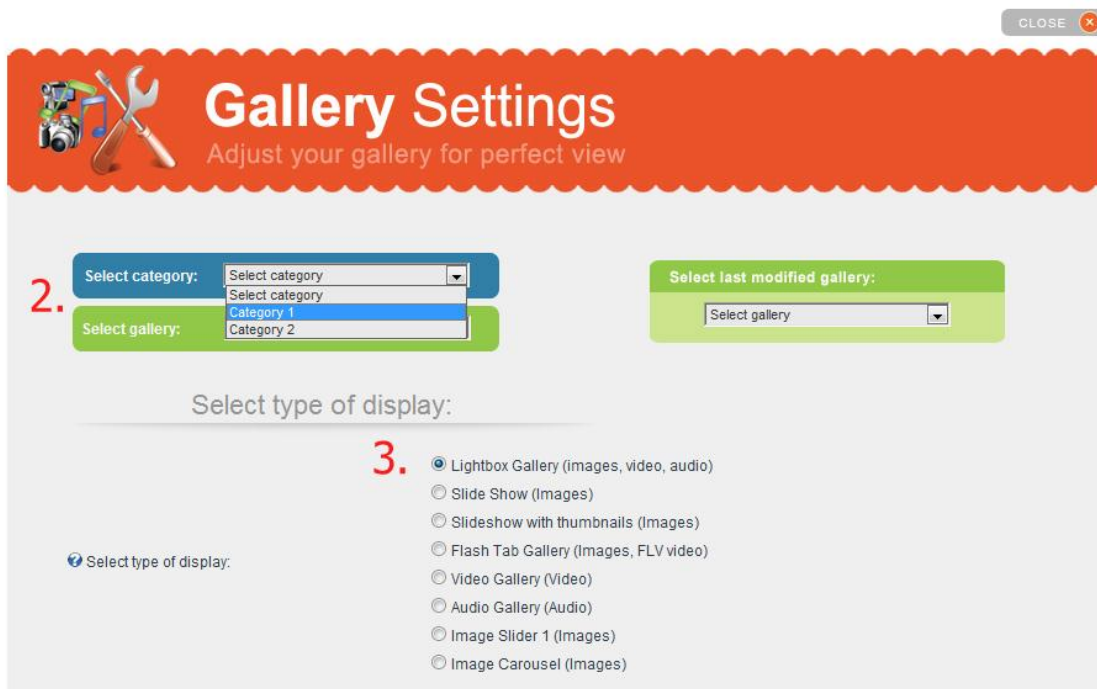


EasyDNNgallery can display galleries which are in a same category as the nested galleries. In order to adjust the display of nested galleries, you must:

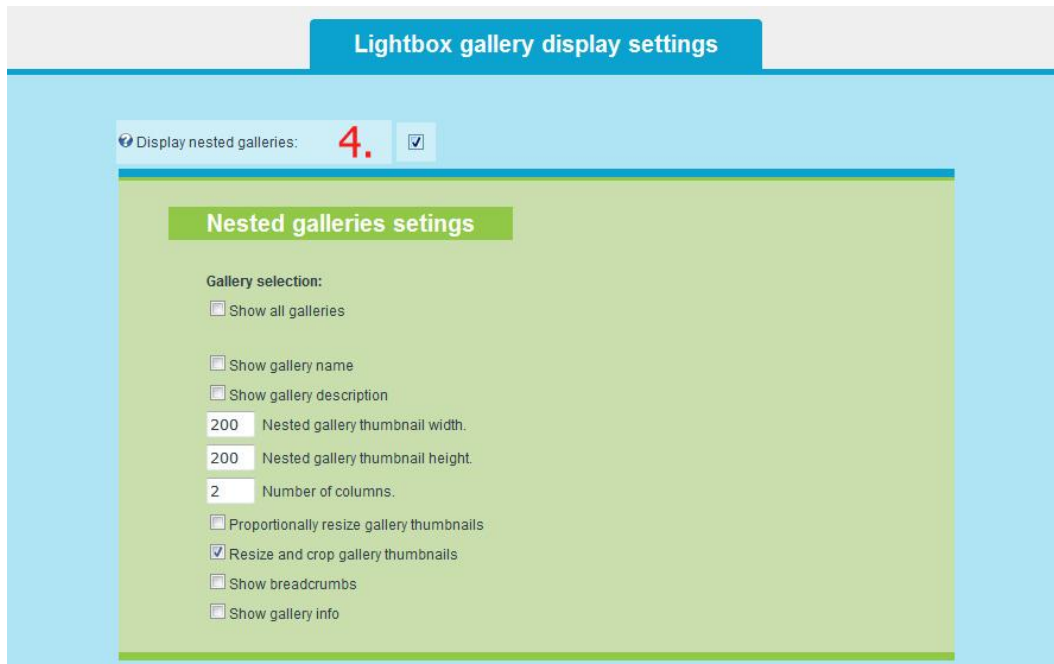
1. Select "**Gallery setting**" on the page where you want to show the gallery.



2. Select a category in which there are galleries that want to display.
3. Select the type of display: **Lightbox**.



4. Check option **"Display nested galleries"** - it opens up additional menu with options to adjust nested galleries display.



Nested galleries Settings

Gallery Selection: mark those galleries that you want to display

Show gallery name: you can choose whether you want to display the name of gallery

Show gallery description: you can choose whether to display a description of gallery

Nested gallery thumbnail width: this determines the width of thumbnails in pixels

Nested gallery thumbnail Height: this determines the height of thumbnails in pixels

Number of columns: determines the number of columns to display nested galleries thumbnails

Proportionally resize thumbnails gallery: here you can select to proportionally resize gallery thumbnails

Show breadcrumbs - you can turn on the display of breadcrumbs

Show gallery info: - you can display gallery info (shows the number and type of files in the gallery)


5. Set all other settings of Lightbox view type

6. **Save settings**

Note: In this version you can display nested galleries only from one category. If you have galleries in different categories, you can display them by creating a new category and copy galleries in this new category.

Save or load settings to another file or module

Gallery settings can be saved and loaded so we do need to adjust them every time. For this it is necessary to check the "**Save or load settings to another file or module**". This opens an additional menu.

Save settings

In the filename field you can write the name under which you want to save the settings. After you have typed the name, click on „**Save Settings**“.

Loading saved settings

To load saved settings select from the menu "**Select Settings**" desired settings filename that you have previously saved. EasyDNNgallery is packed with saved settings from all examples from our demo page.

User upload

To enable user upload go to gallery settings and check „**Enable user upload into this gallery**“. This will open new panel where you can setup user upload. These settings are applied only to current module and current gallery.

First you need to select security roles that will have permissions to upload and approve uploaded media.

If you check “**Approve media**” all media that is uploaded will require approval.

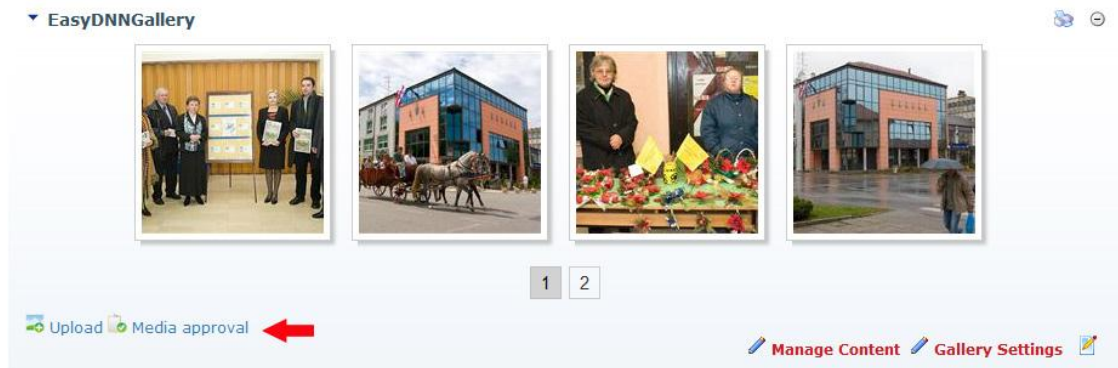
If you check “**Show enter url:**” it will display a field to the uploader to enter link where uploaded media will point to.

In the “**Resize images:**” section you can setup resizing for all uploaded images. After user uploads image it will automatically be proportionally resized.

If you check “**Show only upload control**” it will show only uploading control on that page.

Media approval

To approve media go to “Media approval” control.



Unapproved media for current gallery will be listed.

You can also select other category and gallery and approve media. To approve media simply click on “Approve” link. You can also select “Show all unapproved media”. This will list all unapproved media that you can filter and sort by user.

Localization

EasyDNNGallery is fully localized. All static text and labels can be localized. This includes admin pages. EasyDNNGallery uses standard “.resx” files for localization. Resource files (“.resx”) are located in the folder “/DesktopModules/EasyDNNgallery/App_LocalResources” and can be edited in the editor or through the Admin>Language interface.

The default language is English, if you want to localize gallery to another language via language editor you must add languages code before “.resx” extension. Example for German the name of new resource file “GallerySettings.ascx.resx” would be “GallerySettings.ascx.de-DE.resx”

How to setup access rights to “Manage Content” and “Gallery Settings”

Role Management in the “General module settings” is another level of security that enables you to select what roles can access “Manage Content” and “Gallery settings” individually. By default is set that all roles that can edit module can have access to both “Manage Content” and “Gallery settings”. If role has edit access on the module you set that it only has access to “Manage Content” or “Gallery settings”. If role does not have edit access to the module role management in the “General module settings” will have no effect. These settings affect all modules in the portal and not only just one module.

What's new in version 4.0

Our well-accepted EasyDNNgallery module has reached its 4.0 edition. Through several versions that preceded this version, we have enabled sharing images through social networks for some layouts, and the most important novelty is the possibility of advanced integration with our newly introduced EasyDNNnews module.

When displayed nested galleries can now be sorted by position, title, date created and date last modified.
