Graduates: **Report at 12:00 P.M. Promptly** - park in the Scovill Street or UCONN garage and use the stage door on Brook Street to enter the Palace (see enclosed directions).

Guests: **1:30 P.M.** – Seating begins inside the theater. Guests arriving at 2pm or later will have to wait until the procession has concluded before seating will be allowed.
Guests use only the front entrance to the theater (100 East Main Street).

Ceremony: **2:00 P.M.** – Commencement begins

NOTE: There is no place to store valuables during the ceremony (i.e. large purses, cameras, etc.), so please only bring what is necessary.

Cap and gown pick up/guest tickets: **Due to the increased number of graduates attending the ceremony only 2 guest tickets per graduate will be distributed** when you pick up your cap/gown. A wait list will be kept for extra tickets during this time if they become available. Make sure you sign up for your extra tickets at this time. **Please note: Graduates do not need a ticket.** Seating at the Palace is odd/even so please do not switch tickets; they are grouped together.

NOTE: Due to fire code regulations, a ticket is required for admission, *including* infants and small children.
