





Enrollments: Fall 2008 to 2013


Headcounts and Full Time Equivalents (FTE)



From 2008-2013, NVCC has experienced a 19% increase in overall enrollment and a 20% increase in FTE.




Breakdown by Gender Fall 2013












The State Department of Administrative Services has received two viable proposals that will allow us to at least triple our space in 2015.
