- 1. Have an overall GPA of 3.00 or higher.
- 2. Have a minimum grade of a B+ in the course you wish to tutor.
- 3. Have taken the course(s) you wish to tutor at NVCC or provided official documentation that you obtained credit for the course that you intend to tutor.
- 4. Obtain two faculty endorsements.

In addition, students selected to the program must complete ACE tutor orientation/training which must be completed before you begin tutoring.
