YES or NO =====> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application period is October 1st through January 15th for fall semester start. • All pre-requisites and General Education classes require a minimum grade of "C". • Current, official transcripts from all prior colleges attended are required regardless of age or applicability to program. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BIOLOGY:[†] BIO 105, 115, or 121 (or equivalent or higher). High School science courses are acceptable to meet this admission requirement <u>provided</u> the course has a <u>lab</u>. High school transcript and course description must be provided. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Job Shadow: Strongly recommended. If unable to secure a job shadow, students are advised to watch this career video. Contact Program Coordinator for details. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA: Minimum 2.5 based on courses that meet the admission and General Education program requirements and ALL sciences taken within the 5 year time-frame (including those sciences that are not admission or program requirements).
