## Transportation/ID

### Bus passes: Pick up your pass in

**Waterbury:** at the Bursar's Office in Kinney K508  
**Danbury:** 2nd floor Administrative Offices.  
Students registered for credit courses are eligible for a bus pass. A valid student ID is needed to receive your NV Rides pass.  
*Waterbury: Bus Number is 442*  
*Danbury: Route 6 or go to Pulse Point depot which is within walking distance to campus.*

### Student ID

To obtain a student ID card, bring the following to the **Information Center** on the **5th floor of Kinney Hall, Room 522**, or the **2<sup>nd</sup> floor Administrative offices in Danbury:**  
⇒ Proof of enrollment (registration receipt or class schedule)  
⇒ Photo ID (driver's license, passport, birth certificate, military or other official ID)
