

Requirements to run for SGA Vice President

- 1. Shall have been a voting member of the SGA for at least one (1) semester.
- 2. Shall have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- 3. Shall be carrying minimum six (6) academic credits.
- 4. Shall present a petition of one hundred (100) signatures from the student body, to the SGA excluding SGA members. (see petition attached)
- 5. Shall submit an essay to the SGA advisors explaining why they want to run for Vice President

Responsibilities of the SGA Vice President

As stated in the SGA Constitution: Vice President

- 1. Shall assume the duties and responsibilities of the President during the absence of the President.
- 2. Shall serve as an ex-officio member of all committees.
- 3. Shall act as the liaison between all committees and the President.
- 4. May not be an officer of any other organization on campus.
